



Before Your Arrival.....

HEALTH 1. Read through and sign a copy of the Guidelines and keep a copy for yourself; Complete the Application, General Health Information, and sign the False Information Clause and Information Releases.

2. Take a copy of the Release of Information Form & Report of Physical Exam to the Laboratory or Doctor's Office to release results of Drug of Abuse Panel and Pregnancy test.

LEGAL 1. Bring your Social Security card and your birth certificate when you move in. You will need them if you apply for public assistance.

2. The Liability Release Form must be notarized and returned with the application for admission. Most banks offer this service.

3. If you have a prior substance abuse history, please (when applicable) include proof of program completion with your application for admission.

4. If you are in an abusive relationship, please provide proof of a personal protection order with your completed application for admission.

SCHOOL 1. If you are attending school or a GED program, take a copy of the Release of Information Form to them, and bring us a complete address and phone number along with the Dean or caseworker's name.

What to bring Clothes, personal items, stuffed animals, games, pictures, tape players.

Do not bring Linens, televisions, live pets, bicycles, furniture, or any items prohibited in the house guidelines.
