



Dear Friend:

Thank you for your interest in New Generation. We are able to provide housing for seven mothers. Rent is based upon the resident's ability to pay. Obviously women are never turned away due to inability to pay but this minimal rent helps cover some of our costs, while teaching residents to be focused on the future, which will undoubtedly include jobs, rent and bills. We receive some funding through grants, private donations, and Second Generation Thrift Shoppe sales.

Any pregnant woman over the age of 18 may apply for residency. We offer shelter, parenting education, living skills, and transportation. Each mother is required to attend a weekly family meeting in the home, attend parent education meetings, perform chores, observe curfews, sign in and out, and either work, go to school, or serve as a volunteer.

The period of residency is through pregnancy and up to three months after birth for women choosing to parent their babies, or up to six weeks for women making an adoption plan. If a mother comes in with an infant, she and her child may stay up to six months or until the baby is a year old.

I have enclosed an application packet. Please complete each form and request your physician to send us proof of pregnancy and a Drug of Abuse Panel.

Return completed packets to New Generation and call to set up an interview. Our team will review your application and will make a decision regarding admission. Please keep us informed with a number at which you can be reached. You will be informed of the decision within 3 business days of your interview.
